Tee Markers:

Yellow – Social Play
Red – Ladies Competition Play
Blue – Men’s Competition Play

Course Toilet:

Located beside the 4th tee.
Entry code is 1432



Flags/Hole Positions

Yellow – Front third of green
Red – Middle Section
White – Back third of green

Social Play & Practise Rounds

Players must report to the Pro-Shop before commencing social play or a practice round and collect a score card. This is the receipt for payment of green fees and will need to be produced if requested by a Staff Member or Director of the Club. Fees subject to change at Board discretion.

Fees:

Sawtell Members \$4 for both 9 or 18 holes
Members Guests \$16 for 9 holes \$23 for 18 holes
Visitors \$20 for 9 holes and \$30 for 18 holes
Twilight golf: After 3pm \$12 for as many holes as you can fit in.

Standards of Dress on Golf Course:

All players must wear appropriate golfing attire. Ladies are required to wear a ***collared shirt*** on the course. Dress regulations may be varied from time to time at the discretion of the Secretary Manager or Match Committees. Not permitted are *singlets, hats or garments bearing offensive slogans or logos.*

Club House Conditions:

Members and visitors are to be suitably dressed at all times. When introducing visitors, the names of such are to be entered in the Visitors Book prior to using the facilities of the club house. Members and visitors are asked not to wear spikes in the Auditorium. Please also remove head-wear before entering the club house and refrain from resting feet on chairs. Children are welcome in the non-licensed sections of the club house, i.e. auditorium. At all times children must be under the supervision of a parent or adult. Golf Clubs and /or buggies are not permitted in the foyer or front office areas and are not be stored in the Clubhouse overnight.
